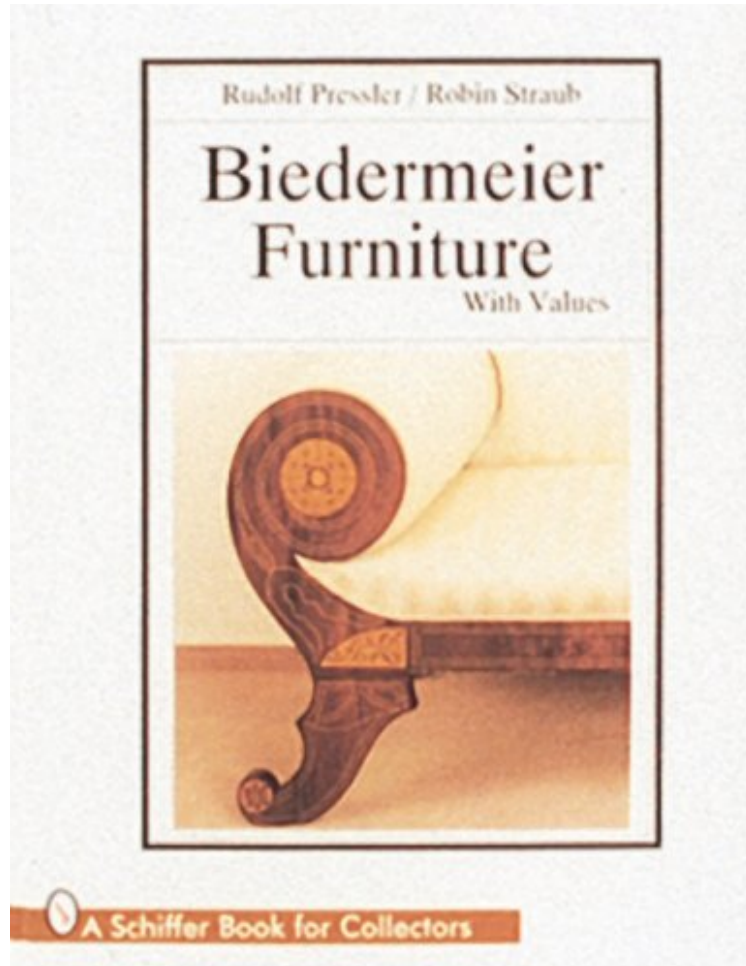

Following the origin information and other background information on designs, from pages 65-96 there are full-color photos of some of the most gorgeous furniture. As the wood is one of the distinguishing features of Biedermeier, this section is invaluable. Prices are given for the pieces featured.Following the full color photos of furniture pieces is a black and white gallery of furniture with

"values" and measurements for over 100 pages. The furniture is organized by type: writing cabinets, high chests of drawers, upright cabinets, wardrobes, secretaries, desks, sofas, benches, armchairs, occasional tables among others. This would be a very helpful book to antique dealers and Biedermeier style enthusiasts because of the abundance of photos to visually teach you about the style.

The beautiful laminated furniture of the nineteenth century is documented in this useful reference book with over 500 illustrated examples from seating to case piece styles.
