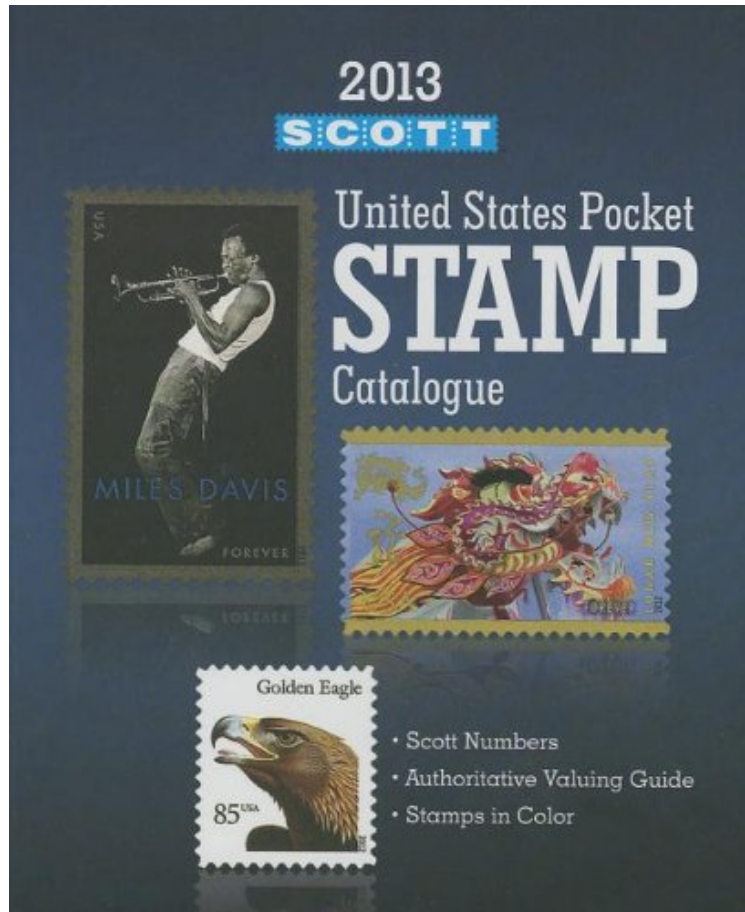

I had been using the Blackbook for US Stamps since 1998 and I find that the pocket catalogue is easier to see, reference capability with color illustrations of the stamps, multiple grading entries for each stamp listed allowing me to use a pencil to mark off what condition and quantity of that stamp per line. The physical size of the catalogue at 6 by 7.5 and at its widest, the binding approximately 1.75 inches.
