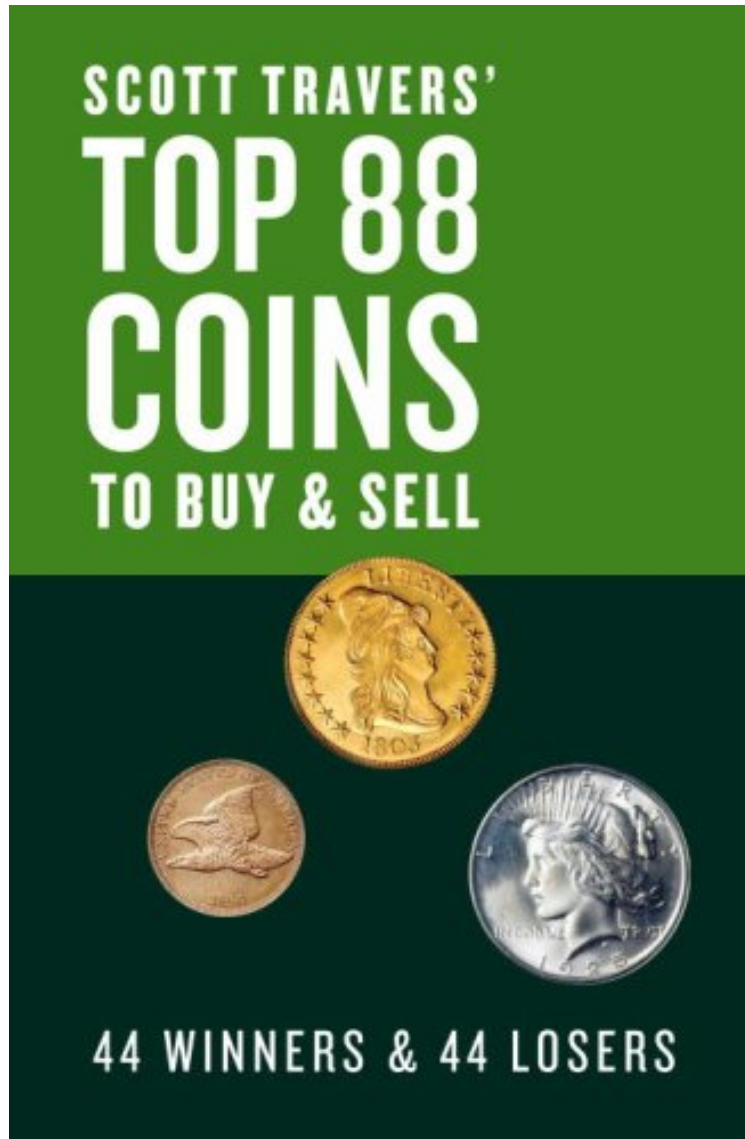

collectors/investors well-heeled enough to spend five and six figures for a single coin. With few exceptions the author's recommendations were the rare and very expensive coins - the 1804 silver dollar, the 1913 Liberty nickel, and many MS-65 and Proof Double Eagles.
