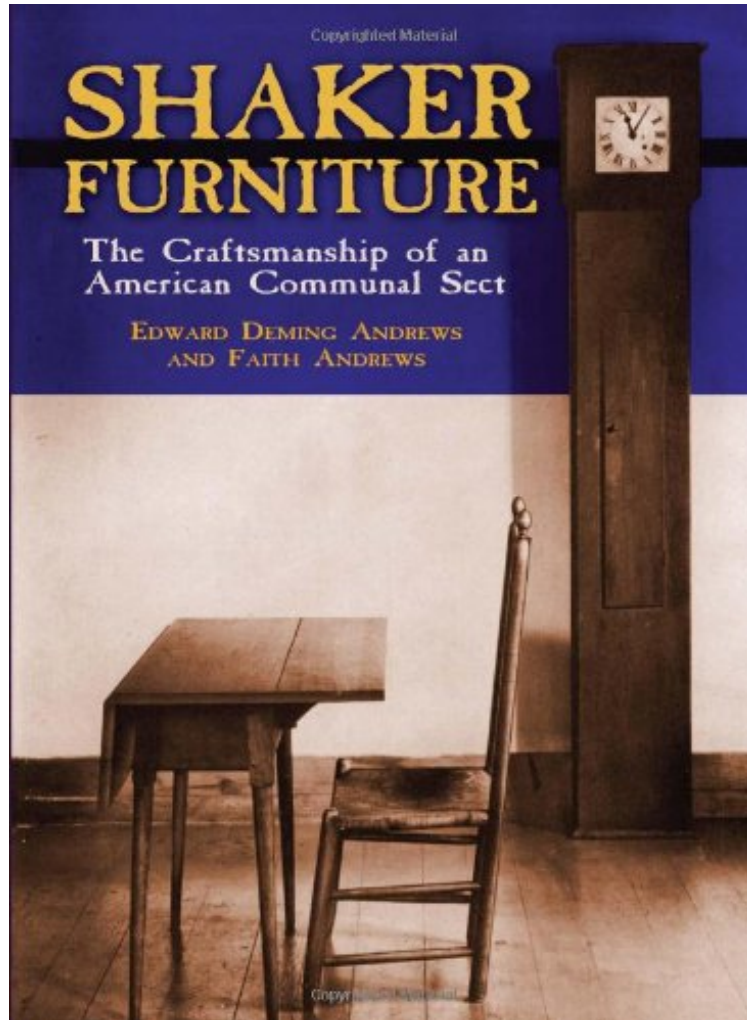

It isn't a stand-alone book for studying shaker furniture but it still has a fair amount to offer when you consider That Edward and Faith Andrews along with Ejner Handberg and a few other early collectors really set the foundation of what we know about shaker furniture.The preview doesn't really show much of the photography of the pieces. The photos are part of the dated aspect of this book. Back in the day they would have been pretty state-of-art shots but not so much now. Still, the photos are relevant because they show some of the more famous pieces in

more original condition before heavy restoration that may have altered the original appearance of each piece.
