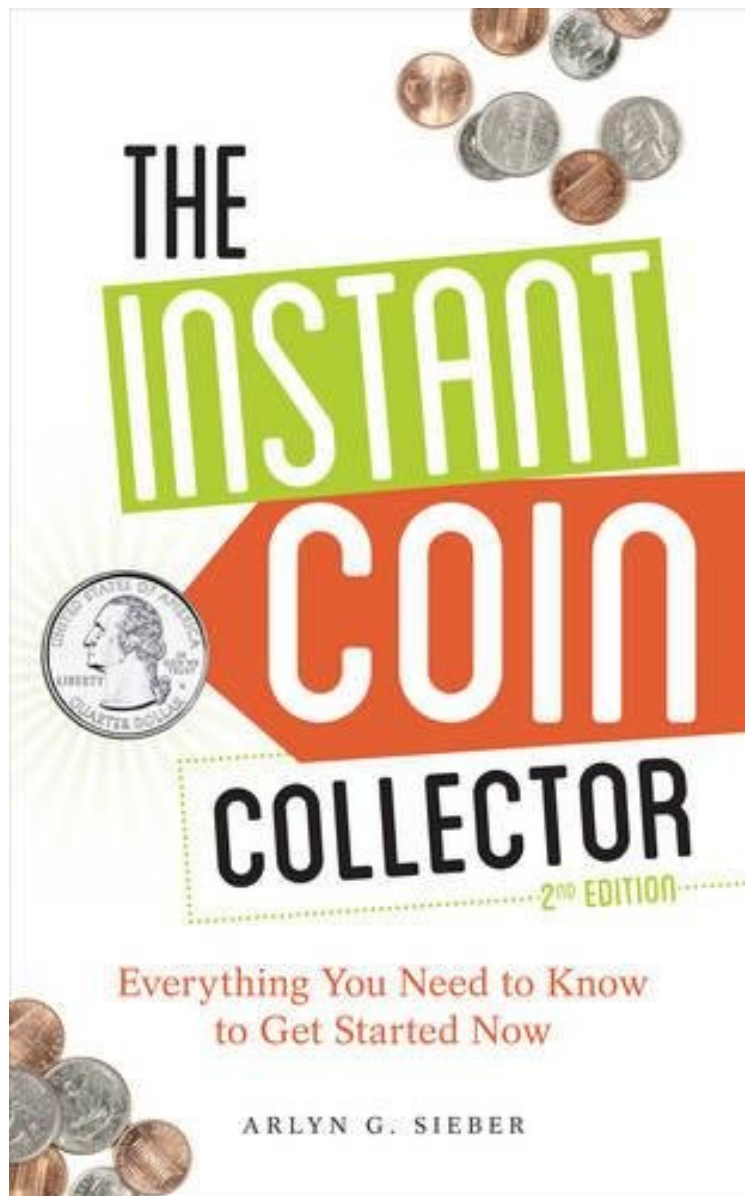

For anyone interested in coin collecting, Sieber's book is worth a look. It's an entertaining, comprehensive and well-illustrated introduction to the hobby. Sub-titled EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW TO GET STARTED NOW, Sieber's book pretty much lives up to that claim. Topping off at 238 pages, he delves into 'Getting a Handle on Coins,' 'How to Get Started,' 'What to Watch For,' etc. Illustrated with hundreds of bw and color photographs and drawings, the book explains numismatics in straightforward, easy-to-understand language, providing a ton of information on basics such as terminology, grading, storing and handling along with helpful hints on collecting strategies and so on. In short, THE INSTANT COIN COLLECTOR is an excellent primer on numismatics and, at \$16.99, it's a bargain as well. Highly recommended..
