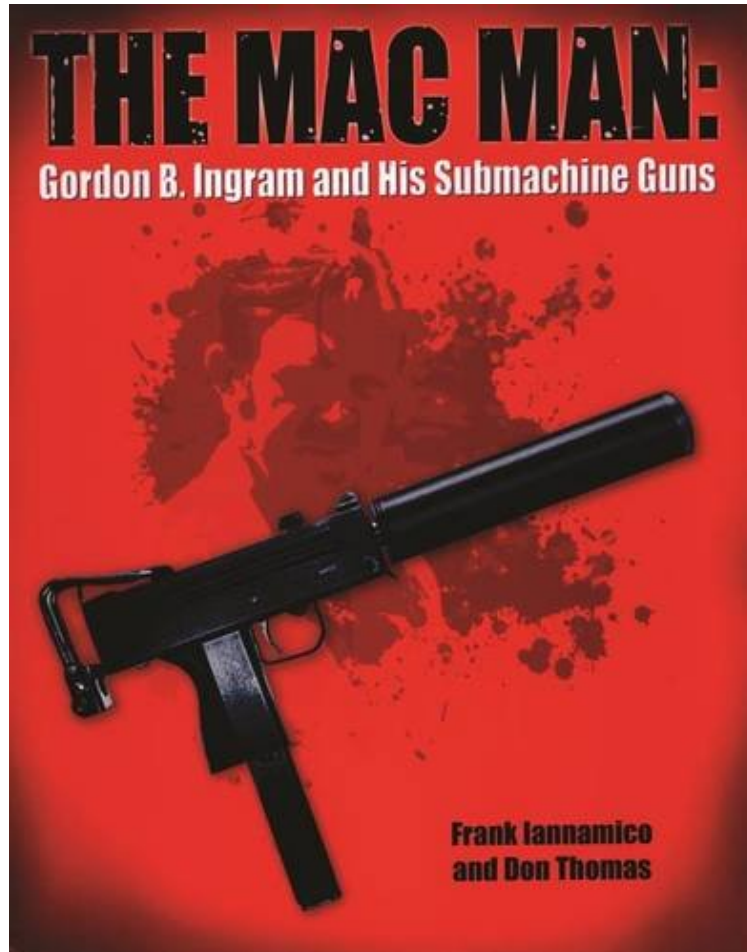

A First Class ActBy Holland1953Being an artist, engineer, designer, draftsman and having a deep interest in firearms since I was 5 years old, I feel that this book captures the essence of this little gun and catalogs the entire history of Gordon Ingram's masterpiece.This book highlights the checkered path on which Ingram's designs ventured making it very obvious that he - like a few other firearms designers - were not part of the so-called 'Ordnance Ring' (not mentioned in the book) and that he fell foul from nearly every single law, government and agency ever devised by mankind.It was painful to read just how many times Ingram's MAC production was stymied by design, production, sales and management change-overs.I have had the opportunity to handle various MACs in various firearms museums and remain fascinated by its simplicity and raw abundance of firepower.I reiterate that I rate this book very highly indeed and hope that a reprint will include more drawing cross -

sections.
