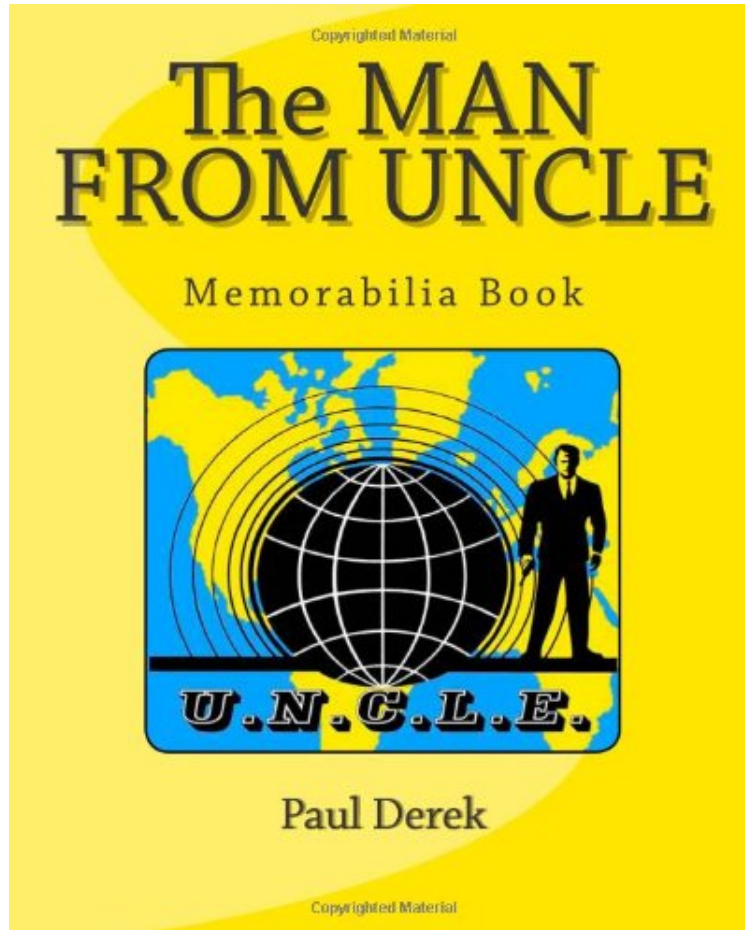

BookBy Ken H.I'm one of the original fans of the great television series "The Man from U.N.C.L.E." and I was really looking forward to reading this book. On the positive side, I can say it was apparently well-researched because it has many images of books, magazines, comics, toys, etc. However, overall it was rather disappointing. This book has potential for an improved, second printing, but it definitely needs work.Here are some examples: (1) the word in the title on the cover and elsewhere should really be "U.N.C.L.E." rather than "UNCLE," (2) there is nothing printed on the spine of the book at all, so if it's on a shelf, you can't tell what the book actually is, (3) some of the images are small and it's difficult to distinguish the details in them, (4) there's no text in it, to describe any background about the show...what years was it on tv, what was the plot of the show all about? (5) there are no page numbers, so you can't tell someone to "look on page so and so at such and such," (6) some of the punctuation is rather curious because it has some words capitalized that shouldn't be, unnecessary exclamation marks which should simply be periods, and several words are spelled

wrong. I think if the author could go back and change these things, and add a short introductory chapter at the beginning which tells at least a little about the series, and have a thorough proof-reading, this would be a much better book. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. So with the recent resurgence in interest due to the Guy Ritchie Man from UNCLE film I found myself looking to see if any new books were out to cash in on it. When I saw this I was overjoyed that a book, in colour, had been published, albeit self published, on the memorabilia from the original, massively successful, 60s TV series. Alas, this is a woefully poor attempt at putting a book together. It feels more like a bunch of bad quality colour copies of images grabbed from the Internet stuck together and dressed up as a book. The copy is minimal and irrelevant, as it's all personal opinion on the quality of the items or the show, and not related to the actual products. Furthermore, it's riddled with spelling mistakes for which there is no excuse in this day and age and terribly laid out with no order or structure. The reason for my ranting is the frustration of such a wasted opportunity. If this were £10 I'd still smart at paying it, but at £50 it's an absolute joke (prices on UK). The Toys from UNCLE remains the benchmark book for UNCLE memorabilia even though it's in black and white.
