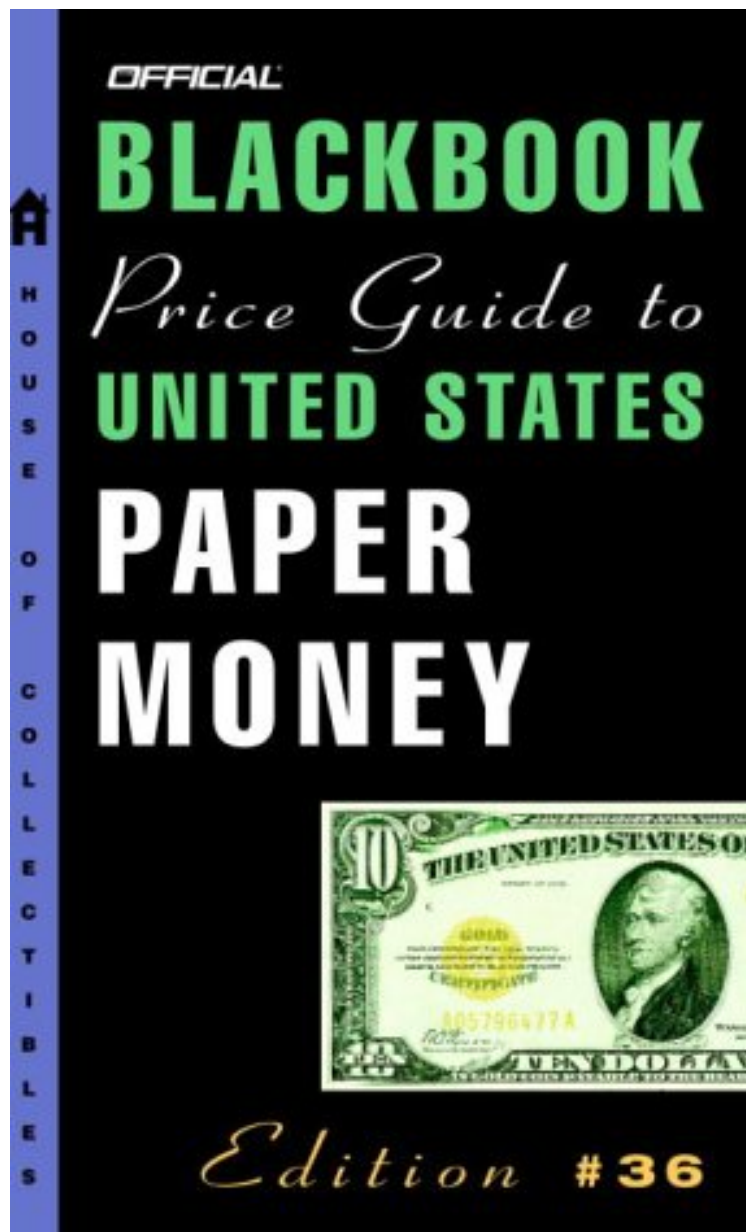

If the newer, larger portrait bills intrigued you enough to start collecting -- you'll find nothing about them. Whether you're a beginning collector or been at it a while, this book is a must SKIP.
