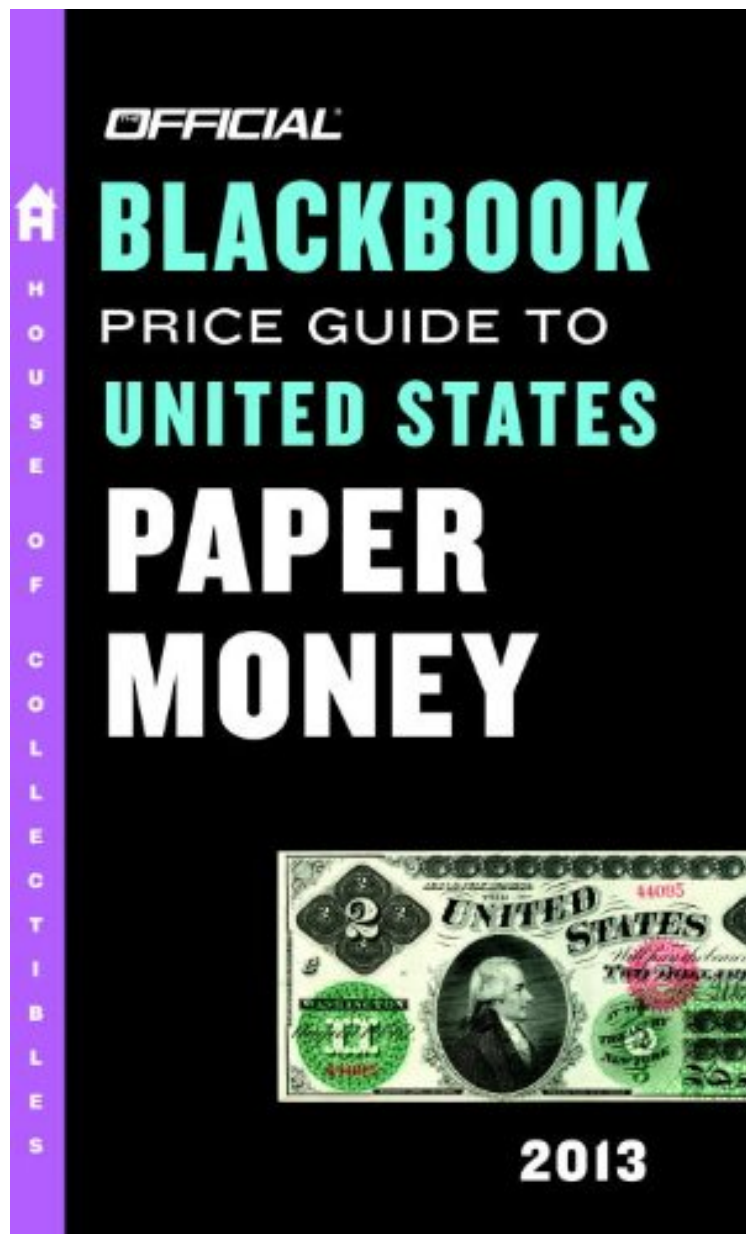

In contrast, the Blackbook is a cheap mass market paperback: no glossy, no color, totally grainy images, no F numbers, text-only grades, pricing for 4 grades. It's a few bucks cheaper, but that's not worth it. The reason I bought it is that Friedberg book is a couple years old (2011) versus the Blackbook which is for "2013" - I assume the prices are more up-to-date.
